The Permanent Mission of the Republic of Malta to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Permanent and Observer Missions of the States Parties to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC) and has the honour to inform of the offer of three scholarships at the University of Malta.

The Government of Malta will be offering following scholarships for students wishing to engage in Postgraduate studies commencing in the academic year 2017/2018:

- Post Graduate Studies to study Adaptation and Resilience to Climate Change
- Post Graduate Studies on Good Governance of Climate Action
- Post Graduate Studies to Develop a Low Carbon Economy

Eligible applicants should be nationals and current residents of one of the countries indicated in the following list available at:

The Permanent Mission of Malta further has the honour to inform that the following funding will be covered by the Government of Malta:

- Payment of the University of Malta Tuition Fees and/or Enrolment fee
- Health Insurance to cover a premium up to a maximum of EUR 500 per year. Students will be guided on this and other arrangements upon arrival.
- Reimbursement for visa expenses amounting to EUR 60.
- A monthly subsistence allowance amounting to EUR 750 per month to be used towards accommodation, living, transport, academic expenses and any other expenses that may arise. Students will receive this monthly allowance for a maximum and continued duration of 16 months. The study programme must be completed on a full-time basis within the same time-frame.
- One return journey to the home country the cost of which is capped at EUR 1,000. Additional trips or travel costs higher than this amount will have to be covered by the student.

Applicants wishing to submit their interest need to do so online and provided copies of their academic qualifications and all other requested documentation to the University of Malta by the 5th May 2017. A document is enclosed for additional information.

The Permanent Mission of the Republic of Malta to the United Nations avails itself of this opportunity to renew to the Permanent and Observer Missions of the States Parties to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC) the assurances of its highest consideration.
