DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Require to travel on Patrol Boat when assigned during routine monitoring of the Palau Exclusive Economic Zone, inclusion of special operations; enforcement of marine safety laws; Observe and checks activities, licenses, permits and catches of illegal foreign fishermen and fishing vessels, inclusion of illegal human and narcotics smuggling; Patrols at sea to protect peoples and ROP natural marine resources; Inspects vessels for proper safety equipment, compliance with all fishing and boating regulations and licenses; Works commercial activity at wharves and boat landings where this activity is prevalent; issues warnings, make arrest, gather evidence, and testifies in court in order to enforce laws, rules and regulations as well as assist in the prosecution of offenders. Maintenance and service of all patrol boats, inclusive of other small patrol boats to addition to these duties, officer must perform seamanship and/or engineering, and/or electrician duties when assigned on land or at sea.
- Performing daily monitoring at sea port and sea (near shore) to ensure water safety compliance; monitor the activities of suspicious individuals on the water; investigate incoming reports, observe incidents of law violation and other problems in order to further marine resource conservation, protect property and foster good public relations;
- On night watch; confers with other law enforcement to coordinate activities and provide assistance; Patrols and visits conservation area to check for illegal fishing, harvest and catches unlicensed operations; completes and submits required reports and paperwork.
- Participate/partake in appropriate training/ development programs to enhance/increase skills in specialized law enforcement.
- Provide 24hrs response to all emergency calls at sea, inclusive of search & rescue mission; remains updated on current training techniques and opportunities.
- Perform other duties assigned by the supervisor, Division Chief or Director.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS AND OTHER REQUIREMENTS:**POLICE OFFICER I (Trainee)**

Must have a high school diploma or equivalent. Must have received or attended some law enforcement trainings in addition to Basic Police Academy. Must have one 1 year on the job experience as a certified Law Enforcement Officer and have performed at an acceptable level. Position requires completion of the Physical Fitness Training Program, Police Academy and the Firearm Qualifications aspect of the National Law Enforcement Academy or similar structure. Extreme confidential is required. No felony convictions or more than two misdemeanors in crimes of violence, crimes involving dishonesty or moral turpitude in any jurisdiction.

Must undergo drug testing under the supervision of the Director, Bureau of Maritime Security & Fish & Wildlife Protection, and if tested positive, will be required to take another test within 5 working days, and if tested positive again, will be disqualified and will not be eligible to reapply for employment with the national government for a period of 3 years (see PNC33 §1203 (b) and §1205).

And if employed, and tested positive twice refer to ***PNC33 §1203 (b), §1204 (a & b)***; and his/her name shall be forwarded to the Office of the Attorney General as stated in ***PNC33 §1207***. Unwilling to cooperate with appropriate testing or provide relevant documents shall not be eligible. Must have a valid Palau's driver license. Will be required to operate police vehicle, boat, motorcycle. Use of computer and typewriter.
