

DECEMBER 2018 QTR KEY POINTS

- Total BGRT collected this quarter decreased by 12.8% compared to the same quarter last year.
- Mining and quarrying and Construction activities both showed increases of 44.0% and 18.6%, respectively. This is likely due to the high demand for construction developments including the road re-surfacing.
- Tourism related industries that showed decreases this quarter includes Accommodation and food service activities, Administrative and support service activities, Transportation and storage, and Wholesale & retail trade; repair of motor vehicles and motorcycles at 26.8%, 17.5%, 6.9% and 0.8% respectively. These decreases are in line with the decline in visitor arrivals.
- Real estate activities saw a significant drop of 79.6%. Last year's high numbers was mainly due to increased space rental receipts and property leases.
- Other industries include Water Supply, Sewerage, Waste Management; Information and Communication; Education; Human Health and Social Work; Arts, Entertainment and Recreation; and Activities of extraterritorial organizations and bodies which increased by about 188.2%, likely due to high returns of information and communication industry.



- Total BGRT Non-filers include all registered businesses with active business status that failed to file quarterly GRT.
- The total number of Non-Filers this quarter has decreased by about 30.1% compared to the same quarter last year.



DECEMBER 2018 QTR KEY POINTS

- Business Licenses must be renewed by December 31st of each year to avoid penalty and interest fees. The table above shows the cumulative number of business licenses issued for 2017 and 2018.
- To date, there have been a total of 2,451 licenses issued for business year 2018.
- Industries that experienced significant increases include Other service activities; Construction; Other industries; and Professional, scientific and technical activities at 15.9%, 12.9%, 12.8% and 10.6%, respectively.
- Tourism related industries that showed decline include Transportation and storage, Accommodation and food service activities, and Administrative and support service activities at 7.3%,



- 2.1%, and 7.9% respectively. These decreases are in line with the decline of visitor arrivals.
- Other industries include Information and Communication, Financial and insurance activities, Public
 administration and defence; compulsory social security, Education, Human Health and Social
 Work, Arts, Entertainment and Recreation, and Activities of extraterritorial organizations and
 bodies.



DECEMBER 2018 KEY POINTS

- Overall wages collected this quarter increased by 4.2% compared to the same period last year.
- Agriculture industry showed a decline of 22.5%, likely associated with the increase in fuel price.
- Mining & quarrying and Construction industries both showed increases, possibly connected with the increased construction projects including the road re-surfacing.
- Conversely, tourism related industry such as Wholesale and retail trade, Transportation and storage, Accommodation and food service activities, and Administrative & support service activities all showed decreases likely driven by the decline of visitor arrivals.



 Other Industries include Water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities, Information and communication, Activities of extraterritorial organizations and bodies, Arts, entertainment and recreation, Human health and social work activities, Electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply, Activities of household as employers, undifferentiated goods- and services-producing activities of households for own use, and Other service activities.



DECEMBER 2018 QTR KEY POINTS

- Quarterly employment numbers are derived by averaging total number of people filing returns at the end of the quarter. Industry employment counts are classified based on the business activity as disclosed on their Social Security activity description.
- Overall, the total average employment declined by 2.3% compared to the same period last year.
- Agriculture and forestry industry experienced a drop of 11.9%, likely associated with the wages numbers.
- Tourism related industries such as Wholesale and retail trade, Transportation and storage, Accommodation and food service activities, and Administrative & support service activities all showed a decline this quarter. These decreases were likely driven by the decline in visitor arrivals.
- Other industries include Electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply, Information and communication,



Financial and insurance activities, Human health and social work activities, Arts, entertainment and recreation, Activities of household as employers; undifferentiated goods and services-producing activities of households for own use, and Activities of Extraterritorial organizations and bodies.
