Alli from the Republic of Palau. Regarding MPIIC-20-186 dated 11 December 2020, which informed all the concerned airlines of the postponement of the effective date of New Airport Charges Schedule of the Palau International Airport to 1 July 2021, I have again decided to postpone the effective date from 1 July 2021 to **1 October 2021**. This is because of the anticipated delay of the construction works of the New Terminal Building due to the COVID-19 situation. Please kindly refer to the revised "New Airport Charges Schedule" for details of these new airport charges, which is attached to this note.

Palau International Airport Corporation (PIAC) will directly contact all the airlines to conclude a new facility usage agreement. You may discuss questions on implementation details, if any, with them on that occasion.

As I stated in the previous announcement, this airport project is an exciting milestone for the Republic of Palau, and for our relationships with airline partners as well. PIAC, the management arm of the terminals, will be dedicated to quality service to the passengers and airlines.

To the Representatives of Airlines flying to Palau

Dear Sirs and Madams,

Let me express our appreciation for your continued support to the Palau International Airport Corporation (PIAC). While maintaining the passenger terminal with the bare minimum cost in order to weather the rough period caused by COVID-19, we are focusing our efforts on the construction of the new terminal and preparation for its opening.

Unfortunately, however, we are afraid the completion and opening of the new terminal will be further delayed. This is the reason why the effective date of the New Airport Charges Schedule is further postponed to **1 January 2022** from the previously planned 1 October 2021, as the Palauan Government has informed you with its announcement, MPIIC-21-126.

As for its implementation process, PIAC is planning to contact you and ask for the revision of the facility usage agreement when you are ready to resume your schedule flights to Palau. The facility usage agreement with each of you must be revised by at the latest 1 October 2021. Time schedule could be tight. We would like to ask for your kind understanding and cooperation.

New Airport Charges Schedule

The following schedule will take effect on 1 October 2021.

(1) Enplaned and deplaned passenger service charges:

\$12.00 per each arriving passenger

\$16.50 per each departing passenger

\$6.00 per each in-transit passenger, with a minimum charge of USD30.00 per flight

(2) Baggage conveyor belt usage fees:

\$183 per flight

(3) Boarding bridge usage fees:

\$200 per flight

(4) Check-in counter usage fees:

\$104 per flight
